

GriP AntiSlip Cleaning Recommendation

GriP AntiSlip is dirt and water repellent coating. Please follow the below cleaning recommendations to make sure you will benefit from a slip-free shower for many years to come.

- Clean the surface with a soft soap or commercial available bathroom cleaner. The cleaner should be pH-neutral (pH-value of 7 to 8). Always follow the manufacturer's user guidelines and always dilute high concentrate cleaners. Clean the GriP surface at least once a week.
- Lime scale removers can be used to remove lime scale from the surface (pH-value of 4 up 5). Always follow the manufacturer's user guidelines and always dilute high concentrate cleaners.
- Use a soft brush to remove heavy soiling.
- Use water to clear the surface after using the cleaner.
- Finally, make sure to dry the surface with a towel or cloth (this will prevent calcification by water that has been left on the surface).

- Do not use chemical substances which contain strong acids, alcohol or solvents (like aggressive descaling agents, alcoholic disinfectants), as these can damage the surface. If these substances make contact with the surface please make sure to clear with an abundant amount of water.
- Do not use strong acids like hydrochloric acid, bases like Sodium hydroxide, chlorine like chlorine oxide or amines directly on the surface. Check the Safety Data Sheet.
- Do not use a cleaner or a cleaning procedure which works abrasive (sponge for kitchen top, scouring cream, steel wool, etc.).
- Avoid contact with hair dye products, colour mousse etc.
